a) 50p Collection

You are invited to bring 50p every time you come to church during Lent. At the end of Lent, this money will be sent to help the many refugees from Syria, Iraq and Afghanistan who are living in makeshift camps in Greece.

The Prayer Group at St Oswald's are appealing for knitted or crocheted squares (c.9") which they will stitch together to make shawls and blankets for those in the refugee camps. If you are able to make a square or two, it would really help. There's a box at the back of church.

Why we care...

13.5 million people in Syria need humanitarian assistance due to a violent civil war that began in 2011 - 5 million Syrians are refugees, and 6.3 million are displaced within Syria; half of those affected are children. Most Syrian refugees remain in the Middle East - in Turkey, Lebanon, Jordan, Iraq and Egypt; contrary to what you might read or hear in the media, only about 10 percent of the refugees have fled to Europe.



PRAYER THOUGHT FOR LENT (4)

Take a moment or two to be quiet in yourself. As you become quiet, gently notice your breathing... As you quieten down, your breathing will slow a little. As it slows, try gently breathing in to the count of 4, holding your breath for a moment, and then gently breathing out to the count of 4. Try this three or four times until you feel calm and relaxed in yourself. Then, very slowly, read the following poem by Edwina Gatreley, a line at a time:

Be silent.

Be still.

Wait before your God.

Say nothing.

Ask nothing.

Be still.

Let your God look upon you.

That is all.

God knows.

God understands.

God loves you with an enormous love.

God only wants to look upon you with love.

Quiet.

Still.

Be.

Let your God love you.
