**MASS OF THANKSGIVING WITH NEW CATHOLICS**

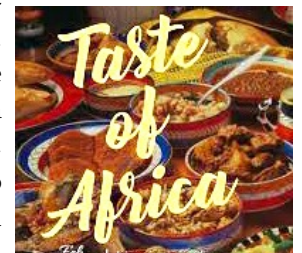

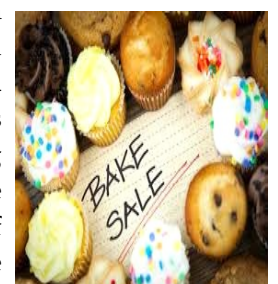


**SUGAR RUSH BAKE SALE**

We owe it to each other to keep personal data safe and secure, and the new legislation will help us to improve the systems we already have in place for doing this. ## ADOREMUS YOUTH CONGRESS

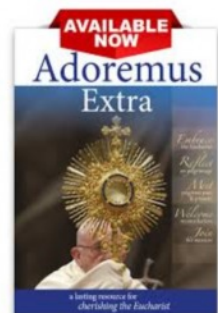
