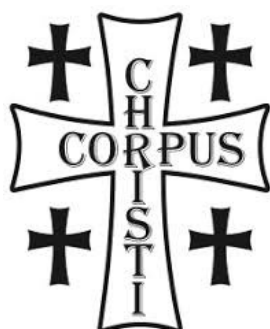

**ORDINATION OF DEACONS**

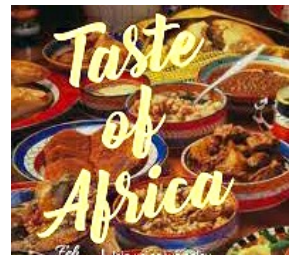

We owe it to each other to keep personal data safe and secure, and the new legislation will help us to improve the systems we already have in place for doing this. 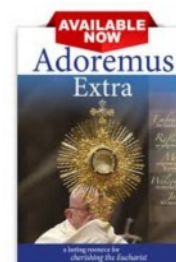
