**Important Notice about Padgate Walking Day**

Following last year's Walking Day, I received a complaint concerning some of the people lining up outside St Oswald's. There were so many people at the entrance to the car park that the crowd spilled out onto the road and into the procession. When teachers reacted to protect the children in their care, they were met with verbal abuse from a few adults. This is not acceptable at any level. To prevent anything like this happening again, there will be an increase in the number of marshals present at St Oswald's for this year's walk. People will not be allowed to gather at the entrance to the car park, and the marshals will be instructed to move people along the pathway should it become overcrowded. I would be most grateful if those gathering outside St Oswald's would assist the marshals and not obstruct them. The marshals are there to ensure the event runs smoothly and is enjoyable for everyone. Failure to adhere to their instructions will jeopardise the future of Padgate Walking Day. 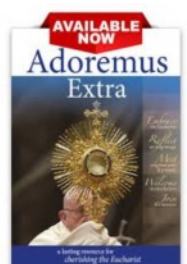
