**DAY FOR LIFE**

Today is the annual Day for Life – the day in the Church's calendar dedicated to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death.

This year's Day for Life aims to raise awareness of the vile crime of human trafficking.

In his latest Apostolic Exhortation, *Gaudete et Exsultate*, Pope Francis says: **"Our defence of the innocent unborn, for example, needs to be clear, firm and passionate, for at stake is the dignity of a human life, which is always sacred... Equally sacred, however, are the lives of the poor, those already born, the destitute, the abandoned and the underprivileged, the vulnerable infirm and elderly exposed to covert euthanasia, the victims of human trafficking, new forms of slavery, and every form of rejection"** (GE 101).

Invoking the intercession of the Patron Saint of victims of human trafficking and modern slavery, St Josephine Bakhita, Pope Francis has sent his Apostolic Blessing to those marking Day for Life in England and Wales. The Holy Father prays "that God might free all those who have been threatened, wounded or mistreated by the trade and trafficking of human beings and bring comfort to those who have survived such inhumanity."

The Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has responded to the rise in these inhumane crimes by developing the **Santa Marta Group** – a global alliance of international police chiefs, bishops and religious communities working in partnership with civil society to eliminate human trafficking and modern slavery. It is named after the house where Pope Francis lives and where the founder members stayed in 2014 prior to signing an historic declaration of commitment. In the UK alone, it is estimated that every year there are over 13,000 victims of trafficking. Day for Life asks for your prayers and donations in supporting those that work to restore their lives to the full. Today's **Second Collection** will go to support this vital work.
